## The Worst Of The Worst

The Pharisees were confident in their self-righteousness, while looking down on others. The truth of the matter is that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23). Will you turn from your sinful life and obey the Gospel (Acts 2:47)? Will the "worst of the worst" enter Heaven before you because they obeyed the Gospel and were cleansed while you were not?
